In support of a focus on education and advocacy for women of all ages, ethnicity, and beliefs, KBPW is looking to award a scholarship to a woman returning to school to further her education. The scholarship is named in memorial for long time KBPW member, Diadama Mason. Diadama was a local school teacher and supporter of women's issues.

The criteria for the scholarship are as follows: The applicant must be female, attending school at least part-time, and a graduate of high school for at least one year prior to attending post-secondary education. The attending school, college, or university must be local. Please do not apply if you do not meet the scholarship criteria.

Please answer all of the questions on the application sheet and attach all other requested information. The scholarship ranges from \$250.00 to \$500.00 and, as it is a scholarship, the money does not have to be repaid. **The due date to be considered for this year's scholarship is Friday, March 20, 2015.** Applications received after this date will not be accepted. If you are awarded a scholarship, in order to receive it you must provide a canceled paid bill or another acceptable form proving current school enrollment.
