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COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS 2016 Undergraduate Scholarship Program POSTMARK DEADLINE: October 31, 2015

A. Eligibility

- Applicant MUST have attended a Chicago area (Boone, Cook, DeKalb, DuPage, Grundy, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Lake, LaSalle, McHenry, and Will counties in Illinois; Lake and Porter counties in Indiana; Kenosha and Walworth counties in Wisconsin) high school.
- Applicant MUST be a college sophomore or junior. Juniorlevel applicants MUST have one full year of coursework remaining at the beginning of the Fall 2015 term.
- 3. Applicant **MUST** be seeking a career in construction.
- 4. Applicant **MUST** PURSUE A BS DEGREE in an approved construction curriculum such as Construction Management, Civil Engineering, or Mechanical Engineering. A dual degree with an approved construction major is acceptable.
- Applicant **MUST** be attending one of the following 5. institutions: Ball State University, Bradley University, Eastern Michigan University, Ferris State University, Illinois Institute of Technology, Illinois State University, Indiana State University, Indiana University/Purdue University - Fort Wayne, Indiana University/Purdue University - Indianapolis, Iowa State University, Marquette University, Michigan State University, Michigan Tech, Milwaukee School of Engineering, Northwestern University, Purdue University, Rose-Hulman Institute of Engineering, Southern Illinois University, University of Detroit-Mercy, University of Evansville, University of Illinois @ Urbana-Champaign, University of Illinois-Chicago, University of Michigan, University of Notre Dame, University of Wisconsin - Madison, University of Wisconsin - Stout, Valparaiso University.
- 6. Applicant **MUST** be enrolled as a full time student.
- 7. Applicant **MUST** be a U.S. citizen or **documented** permanent resident of the United States.

B. Requirements

- 1. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are postmarked or emailed (*e-mail for application only*) by October 31, 2015:
 - a. Completed three-page, signed application.
 - b. **Two** evaluation forms completed by college professor, faculty advisor or career counselor.
 - c. **One** evaluation form completed by an adult not related to the applicant and not a faculty member.
 - d. Evaluation forms should be in sealed envelopes with the evaluator's name signed across the seal.
 - e. **Official** transcript in a sealed envelope(s).
- 2. Incomplete application packages will **NOT** be considered.

C. Awards

1. Scholarships will be a maximum of \$4,000 per student per year and may be renewable for up to two years of undergraduate study toward a degree in an approved construction curriculum as indicated in A4 above. Maximum award: \$8,000 per person.

- Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by the Builders Foundation, which will consider the applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, adult evaluations, and financial status.
- 3. All applicants selected as semi-finalists must attend a personal interview with Builders Foundation representatives in our offices. Interviews will be conducted, ideally, in January, but no later than April.
- 4. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than April 15, 2016.
- 5. Checks will be written to the student or to both the student and the university/college (*\$2,000 per semester*).
- 6. For subsequent award installments, all scholarship winners are required to provide indications of continued need, interest in construction, enrollment and good standing in a college program, including a minimum G.P.A of 2.5/4.0 or equivalent and progress toward a degree acceptable to the Foundation. Grade transcripts and upcoming class schedule must be forwarded at the conclusion of each academic period. Recipients will not be reminded to provide this information; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the program.
- 7. Recipient is strongly encouraged to seek summer employment in construction during undergraduate enrollment.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the recipient to notify the office of the Builders Foundation if a situation arises where the recipient is unable to meet the conditions of this scholarship. Failure to do so may result in loss of the award.
