What is the MTW Student Hackathon?

The Michigan Tech Week Hack-A-Thon is a 10 day prototype creation challenge. Your goal is to use technology to solve for a unique challenge facing Michigan. Your pitch must discuss the challenge you're solving for and demonstrate the technology you've built.

- Aug 29: Applications open
- **Sep 15:** Applications due. Team formation begins.
- Sep 25: Team applications are due and judging criteria released.
 Teams have 10 days to hack their solution.
- Oct. 4: Teams will have 2 HOURS to work on their project and meet with their mentor before pitching to a panel of screening judges. Final pitching teams will be announced and notified at 2pm on October 4th.

Hack-A-Thon Requirements

Eligibility

 Any currently enrolled student in Michigan-based post-secondary degree or certificate-granting institution, including 2-4year colleges, universities, and technical training programs.

- Cannot have an MVP
- Cannot have any revenue
- Cannot have any funding
- Cannot have a pre-existing team
- Cannot have any materialized progress besides a cool idea

- \$10,000 in cash prizes
