



WEST MICHIGAN AWMA SCHOLARSHIP

The West Michigan Chapter of the Air & Waste Management Association (WM-AWMA) is pleased to announce the availability of up to four individual scholarships, each in the amount of **\$2,000.00**, to be awarded to selected college juniors, seniors and graduate students pursuing a career in qualifying environmental studies. Qualified courses of study include environmental engineering, physical or natural sciences, and natural resources, students in other related fields may also qualify. Each successful applicant will receive a one-year student membership in the WM-AWMA.

Scholarship application instructions and a link to the online application are available on the WM-AWMA website, <http://wmawma.org>. Applications must be submitted online no later than midnight on **Sunday, November 26, 2017**. The Scholarship Committee will notify each successful applicant on or before December 14, 2017, and scholarship checks will be issued in January 2018.

At the start of the first term in 2018, applicants must be enrolled as full-time students (at least 12 credit hours) in a field of study leading to a career in air pollution control, waste management or other environmental management field. If in doubt as to the suitability of a curriculum or course of study, applicants may contact the Scholarship Chairperson, Brian Rice, at the email address provided below.

Scholarship applicants are required to have declared their major and attained at least a junior or senior class standing, or to be entering graduate school pursuing a graduate degree. Quality of essay, GPA and student activities will be of primary interest. Applicant should have at least a “B” average (i.e., 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale).
