Student Scholarship Announcement



History

Since 1968, Wisconsin Society of Land Surveyors (WSLS) have been promoting the profession of land surveying in Wisconsin by providing financial assistance to students currently pursuing an education in land surveying. The WSLS Foundation along with Berntsen International, Seiler Instrument, and Leica Geosystems continue this tradition on behalf of the WSLS Society by offering the following scholarships.

New this Year! The first 20 complete applications (Annual Institute Scholarships) will be eligible to receive a \$20 Amazon Gift card. Eligible students will receive these gift cards at the beginning of December.

Annual Institute Scholarship

Berntsen International, Seiler Instrument, Leica Geosystems, and the WSLS Foundation will be presenting eight student scholarships totaling over \$20,000 at the Annual Surveyors' Institute at the Kalahari on Thursday evening, January 26, 2023. Berntsen International, Seiler Instrument, and Leica Geosystems will each award a \$2500 student scholarship and the WSLS Foundation will award five \$2500 student scholarships. The WSLS Foundation scholarship will be presented to students in honor of Society members in recognition of their contributions to WSLS and the surveying profession. *Note: All Scholarship materials must be submitted by the last day of October, **October 31st, 2022** to be considered for the "WSLS Annual Institute Scholarship."*

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship a student must either be:

- Enrolled and attending one of Wisconsin's colleges that meet the requirements of A-E 6.04 by offering a Land Surveying or Civil Engineering Program: North Central Technical College, Madison Area Technical College (Madison College), Milwaukee Area Technical College, Mid-State Technical College and Northeast Wisconsin Technical College. We will also accept applicants from Fox Valley Technical College and University of Wisconsin-Platteville.
- A Wisconsin resident attending an out of state school, completed one year in a Bachelor of Science surveying program and who is enrolled in the 2nd year or later of that program

Seiler Instrument/WSLS Foundation-Chapter Scholarship

Seiler Instrument and the Wisconsin Society of Land Surveyors Foundation will be awarding one student scholarship, *Seiler Instrument/WSLS Foundation-Chapter Scholarship*, to each of the WSLS Chapters. The scholarship will be presented at each awarding Chapter's first regular meeting immediately following the WSLS Annual Institute for the award amount of \$1000. *Note: All Scholarship materials must be submitted by **December 31st, 2022** to be considered for the "Seiler Instrument/WSLS Foundation-Chapter Scholarships."* See the WSLS scholarship website for eligibility requirements.
