ACEC member firms employ engineers, architects, land surveyors, scientists, and other specialists responsible for millions of dollars of private and public works annually. Member firms range in size from a registered professional engineer to corporations employing thousands of professionals. The Council's mission is to contribute to America's prosperity and welfare by advancing the business interests of member firms.

ACEC/Michigan annually awards 4 - 6 scholarships totaling \$15,000 -\$20,000. Visit the ACEC/M website to see last year's winners. To qualify for consideration for an Education Grant, an applicant must:

- Be a full or part-time student (sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student status) pursuing an engineering or surveying degree and enrolled in an ABET accredited engineering or surveying program; and
- 2. Have, in the past 24 months, worked for a consulting engineering, surveying, or architectural/ engineering firm.

Criteria used in selecting grant recipients are:

- GPA
- School & work references
- Work experience
- Extra-curricular & community activities
- Quality of written essay

Applicants are eligible to win an Education Grant twice.






