## An excellent educational tool for use with K-12 Teachers, Students & Communities

### Why?

The Great Lakes impact our lives in many ways---from drinking water, growing food, creating the weather, manufacturing products, atmospheric deposition of pollutants, transporting goods and natural resources, and global warming. Lake Superior contains 50% of the water in the Great Lakes---which equates to 10% of the

world's freshwater and **nearly half of the United States' and North America's freshwater**. These canvas floor maps are an effective way to engage students in learning about Lake Superior and understanding the watershed concept.

#### For Whom?

Lake Superior floor maps are a terrific teaching tool for K-12 schools, museums, and education centers throughout the Lake Superior watershed: Minnesota, Michigan, Wisconsin, and Ontario. Anyone can order the map, and there are NO requirements for holding workshops, acting as a lending site, nor maintaining and submitting records.
