Michigan Technological University Carnahan Enterprise Scholarship Application



ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is available to eligible sophomore, junior or senior level students participating on an Enterprise team as part of their undergraduate degree program at Michigan Technological University. Both current and first-time Enterprise students are encouraged to apply. Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate degree either in the School of Business and Economics or in the Department of Humanities. There is no restriction as to the specific major chosen within these areas of study. The recipient must have a cumulative G.P.A. of at least 2.50.

The scholarship is renewable for up to two years for students pursuing an Enterprise Concentration and up to three years for students pursuing an Enterprise Minor, contingent upon maintaining a cumulative 2.50 GPA and continued availability of scholarship funds.

TIMING: Applications are accepted during the Fall and Spring semesters and are due by **5pm Friday of Week 7**. After review, the Enterprise Program Office will notify scholarship recipients during **Week 11**. Recipients must be enrolled in an Enterprise Project Course for the **upcoming semester** in order to receive the scholarship.

VALUE: The program will award up to two \$500 merit-based scholarships for an undergraduate degree in Business and Economics and up to two \$500 merit-based scholarships for an undergraduate degree in Humanities each year, dependent on availability of scholarship funding. The scholarship is renewable for each year of enterprise study (up to two years total for the enterprise concentration and three years total for the enterprise minor) contingent upon maintaining a cumulative GPA of 2.50, *and* availability of scholarship funds.
